HOW TO WRITE A PERFECT AP U.S. GOVERNMENT FRQ

Defining the Task Verbs:

- **List/Identify:** Write **ONE** sentence that SIMPLY answers the question.
- **Define:** Write at least **TWO** sentences:
 - -Sentence One must provide the meaning of the concept
 - -Sentence Two must include a detailed example (real or hypothetical)
- **Describe:** Write at least **TWO** sentences:
 - -Sentence One must provide the meaning of the concept
 - -Sentence Two must include a detailed example (real or hypothetical)
- Explain: Write at least <u>THREE</u> sentences:
 - -Sentence One should provide the meaning of the concept
 - -Sentence Two must provide statements that describe a set of facts and clarify the <u>CAUSES/EFFECTS</u> or HOW/WHY of those facts as related to the FRQ
 - -You should use an "If...therefore..." statement to show cause/effect or how/why
 - -Sentence Three must include a detailed example (real or hypothetical)
- Compare: Write at least **THREE** sentences:
 - -Sentence One should provide the meaning of any concepts identified
 - -Sentence Two must explicitly describe the <u>similarities</u> between the concepts
 - -Sentence Three must explicitly describe the <u>differences</u> between the concepts
 - Step 1: Read the prompt 5 times. Try to understand what it's asking.
 - Step 2: Underline the verbs (identify, describe, define, explain, compare etc.)
 - Step 3: Underline or identify the number of tasks for each part of the prompt.
 - Step 4: How many points are you able to earn?
 - Step 5: Brainstorm
